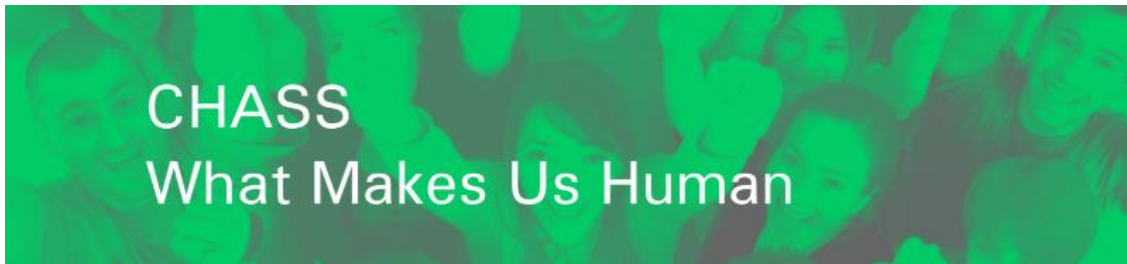
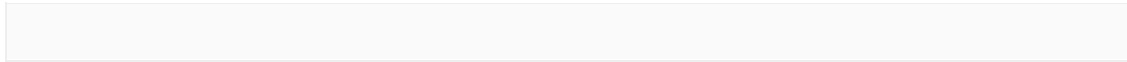

Applications open on 1 May and close on 1 August each year

#### Scholarships for Australians

**Fulbright Distinguished Chair in Agriculture & Life Sciences**  
Sponsored by Kansas State University

For senior level academics to work with Kansas State University faculty in priority research areas leading to ongoing collaborative partnerships between the U.S. and Australia. This Scholarship supports a 5-6 month program, and includes a series of public lectures.

**Fulbright Senior Scholarships**  
For Australian academics (generally at associate professor or professor level) to undertake research at a U.S. institution. This Scholarship supports a 3-4 month program.

**Fulbright Professional Scholarships**  
For aspiring Australian mid-career professionals in the private, public and not-for-profit sectors to undertake training or research programs in the U.S. The Scholarship is also open to academics whose research focus is professional or industry based. This Scholarship supports a 3-4 month program.

**Fulbright Postdoctoral Scholarships**  
For early-career Australian researchers who have completed their PhD in the past three years to undertake postdoctoral research in the U.S. This Scholarship supports a 3-10 month program.

**Fulbright Postgraduate Scholarships**  
For Australian postgraduate students to complete 8-10 months of research in any field; or to support enrolment in a postgraduate program at a U.S. institution.
